## 2. Socio-Economic Indicators

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## Socio-Economic Indicators

### Highlights

Socio-economic indicators provide a background for understanding the health scenario of a country. This section on Socio-economic indicators provides data on education, gender, poverty, housing, amenities, employment and other economic indicators. These indicators for the country and for states will help in identifying the linkages between socio-economic indicators and achievement of health goals.


- Literacy rate of India is 73% as per Census 2011. India's literacy rate at the time of independence was a mere 14%, over the years literacy rate has been increasing but with varied rates in different states with some states like Kerala (94%) and Mizoram (91.3%) well above national average and Bihar with a dismal rate of 61.8%. There is also a concern for female literacy rate (64.6%) which is much below the male literacy rate (80.9%). There is a strong need to improve the overall literacy rate as improved literacy rate has an impact on increasing a country's economic growth rate and decreasing population growth rate. Also as India has a very young population, literacy will play a very important role in turning the young population into potential human capital. (Table 2.1.1)
- Mean age at effective marriage of females has been rising in India. Yet 61 percent of all women (69 percent in rural regions and 31 percent in urban areas) are married before the age of 16. The median age at first pregnancy is 19.2 years. Mean age at effective marriage is highest in J&K (24.4) followed by Kerala (23.1), Delhi (22.8) & Tamil Nadu (22.4), Himachal Pradesh (22.5), and Punjab (22.7). Chhattisgarh (20.3) has the lowest age at effective marriage. The difference in age at effective marriage in rural and urban regions is (2.3 years) maximum in Assam and minimum in Punjab (0.4 years). - Poverty in India is widespread and official measure of Indian government, before 2005, was based on food security and it was defined from per capita expenditure for a person to consume enough calories and be able to pay for associated essentials to survive. Since 2005, Indian government adopted the Tendulkar methodology which moved away from calorie anchor to a basket of goods and used rural, urban and regional minimum expenditure per capita necessary to survive. As per latest information 25.7% of population in rural and 13.7% in urban areas lives below poverty line according to National Institution for Transforming India (NITI AAYOG) estimates for the year 2011-2012, using the Tendulkar Methodology.
- The advance estimates for Per Capita Net National Income for the year 2015-16, at current prices is Rs. 93231 crore and Rs. 77431 crore at constant price (base year 2011-12).
- Safe drinking water is essential for good health. So far 12,70,199 habitations are provided with safe drinking water under Rural Water Supply programme.
- All over the country, 12,711 and 1800 habitations are identified as fluoride and arsenic affected habitations respectively.




